

The first round of our vintage series is just two weeks away, **Sunday** March 23rd at Huffman farms, outside of Donie, Texas. Sign up starts at 8:30am, Riders Meeting at 9:45. Sections open after Riders Meeting. Entry fee is \$25 for ITSA members and \$35 for non members. Plenty of free camping and spectators are free. Donie, TX is centrally located between Houston, Dallas, and Austin.

Physical Address is 1020 Freestone County Road 751, Donie, Tx. 75383

From **Dallas**- Take Interstate 45 South approximately 2 hrs to Buffalo, Tx. Just North of Buffalo exit 180 and take Highway 164 west 10 miles through Donie and then turn left on County Rd 751. Look for the ribbon.

From **Houston**- Take Interstate 45 North approximately 2hrs20min to Buffalo, Tx. Just North of Buffalo exit 180 and take Highway 164 west 10 miles through Donie and then turn left on County Rd 751. Look for the ribbon.

From **Austin**- Take Interstate 35 North to Round Rock. Take Highway 79 East. In Jewett, go North on FM 39 approximately 10 miles and then turn right on Limestone County Rd 846. 846 turns into 751. You will cross a small bridge, don't worry, it will hold any of your rigs. Look for the ribbon. It takes about 3hrs travel time.

We're excited about our first organized ITSA vintage trials series in Texas. Though you don't have to be a member of

ITSA, I would hope that eventually most of you would join to help the cause. Annual membership fee is 40.00. There will be a discounted entry fee for ITSA members of ten dollars per round. So, after riding 4 rounds your membership would pay for itself.

There's a class for everyone, including those on modern bikes. We encourage those on modern bike to come out and have fun and practice those basic things you hate to work on.

Classes as follows: Pre-Historic ('72 & earlier), Historic ('73-'79), Modern Twinshock ('80 to present), Vintage Mono and Modern Mono.

This year we will have 4 lines to choose from: Novice (3), Intermediate (2), Expert (1) and the new Master line (0)
