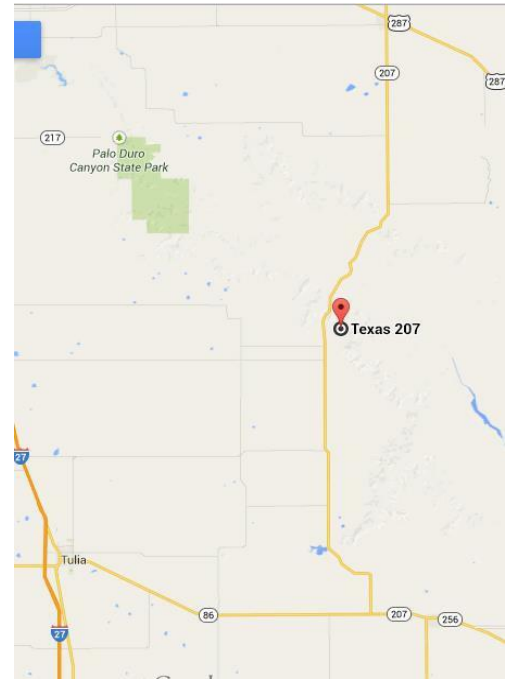

Directions to THE RANCH: 3360 Hwy 207 Wayside, TX 79094 -- 34.785308, -101.429184 for you nerdy types...

From the SOUTH: Take Highway 207 North until you pass FM 285 on your left. Look to the right, there is a rather sizeable barn visible out in the field. That is the event site. There will be a gate on your right with marking indicating the event, leave the gate as you found it.

(OPEN)

From the North: Take Highway 207 South out of Claude, TX 24.5 miles and drive through the Palo Duro Canyon. When you pass the picnic area coming UP out of the canyon, look to your left there is a rather sizeable barn visible out in the field. That is the event site. There will be a gate on your left with marking indicating the event, please leave the gate as you found it. **(OPEN)**

Equipment: All riders must use a motorcycle helmet, DOT-95, Snell-M2000, or NATC approved. **NO BICYCLE HELMETS.** All riders must have their Class designation, visible by the section observer, on the front of their motorcycle. Use a number plate.

Discounted Fees:

Pre-Entry discounts of \$5.00 per round (full price entry only) apply if the entrant pre-enters by each round's designated pre-entry deadline.

Dependent children of a competitor ride at discounted rates (in Classes Novice-Championship) with the purchase of a full price entry fee. Entry fees for the first and second dependent child is \$12.50 if pre-entered, or \$15.00 on the day of the event.

Additional dependent children ride at \$7.50 per round.
