Staturday night TACO dinner!

Note bridge out on OK 49 through the Wichita Mountains Wildlife Refuge.

Located between Hobart, Altus, and Lawton, OK in rural Kiowa County. Suggested routes: From the north, south and east, pass through Lawton, take US 62 west ~22 miles to OK 54 north/right for 11.3 miles to E1530 gravel road (watch for flagging tape) east 2 miles then south on N2330 gravel road 1/3 mile.

From the west I-40 to Sayre, OK then OK 152 west to OK 54 just past Cordell go south/right on 54, then 4-1/2 miles south of Cooperton go left/east on E1530 gravel road (watch for flagging tape) east 2 miles then south on N2330 gravel road 1/3 mile.

Closest lodgings are 19 to 40 miles away. Our 5-star Krehbielhaus (airbnb.com - up to 5 people) we will block for trials riders until April 4. Contact Chris to snap up this up! Closest significant stores are 30 to 40 miles away so plan and provision ahead! We've lots of primitive camping sites, one RV hookup, two full bathrooms, shop, pressure washer.

Saturday & Sunday separate 1-mile loops. AM-PM format, 9 sections each event. Trophies: Master, Expert, Sr. Expert, Intermediate, Sr, Amateur, Adv. Vintage, Vintage, Amateur, Novice, Rookie, and Cadet, plus the Sooner Cup. \$35/rider/day. No pre resgistraition.

Host property will get no event proceeds - all will go to the TACO club fund. Members wanted! NO MEDICAL SERVICES provided. Understanding & signing a liability waiver will be required.
