Rookie: Strider, Cadet, Rookie

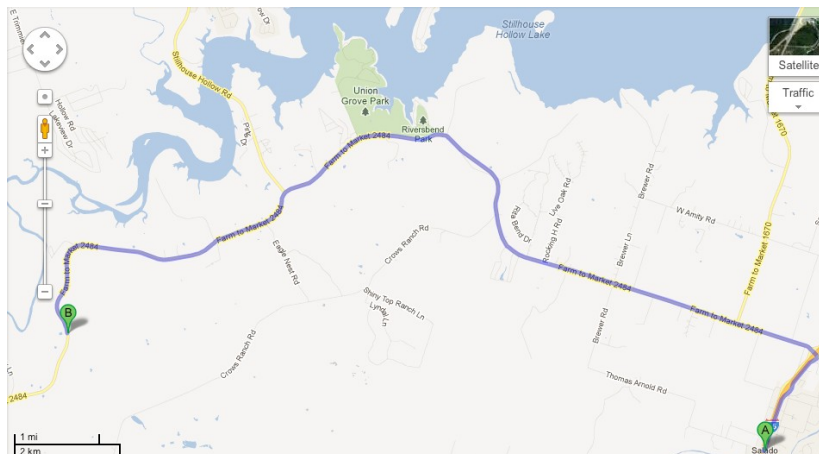
AM: Novice, Women, Advanced Novice, Amateur, Sr Amateur, Vintage, Vintage Expert, ACM

Signup from 8:00 to 9:00, we will start the Saturday's rider meeting at 9:15.

BJ will be at CTOR all day Friday to handle camping etc. The gate will be locked after sunset throughout the weekend. If you are arriving after sun set, contact BJ (512)844-9767, or Ben (512)743-6565 to receive the gate code.

C.T.O.R. is located 11.7 miles west of I---35 on FM---2484, which is just north of Salado. GPS coordinates Latitude: 30.967215, Longitude ---97.67749. You will enter through a white gate on the South side of the road.



FEE Schedule:

Pay at Gate when you arrive: (Can Not be paid with pre-registration)

Land use fee per day = \$10.00 per day per competitor and spectator.

Children below walking age are free

Everyone entering must sign release form. CTOR members do not pay land use fee.

People arriving before 8PM Friday will pay land use for Friday.

Camping per night = \$15.00 per night per camp site.

- Dump site available for campers not hooked up.

- Riders must wear their helmets any time they are on their motorcycle.
- There is a 5 mph speed limit in the pit/camping area.
- Riders must stay on marked trail.
- No riding on grass unless marked for a section.
- Children must be supervised at all times
