This is an AMA sanctioned event and requires AMA membership for all riders. You must have your AMA card with you or you can sign up at the event but I highly suggest you take care of that ahead of time. **All riders are required to attend AM riders meeting** and section judge if asked. Sign up sheets will be at sign up table Friday evening.

Rookie: Strider, Cadet, Rookie

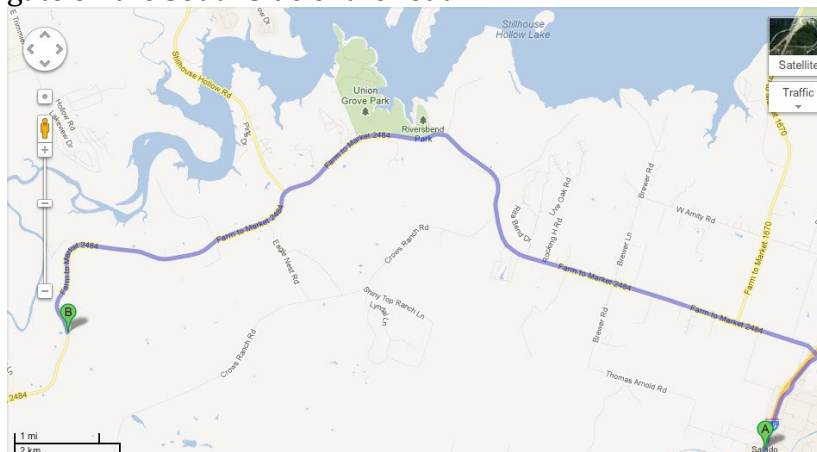
AM: Novice, Vintage, Amateur, Adv Amateur,

Signup starts at 8:00 and has a **HARD CUT OFF at 8:45**. Saturday and Sunday rider meeting at 9:00. Expect a 10:30am start for the Kiddos on Saturday and Sunday.

Ben will be at CTOR at 12 noon on Friday to handle gate and camping fees. The gate will be locked after sunset throughout the weekend. If you are arriving after sunset, contact BJ (512)844-9767, or Ben (512)743-6565 to receive the gate code.

C.T.O.R. is located 11.7 miles west of I---35 on FM---2484, which is just north of Salado. GPS coordinates Latitude: 30.967215, Longitude ---97.67749. You will enter through a white gate on the South side of the road.



FEE Schedule:

Pay at Gate Fee when you arrive: (Can Not be paid at event registration)

Land use fee per day = \$20.00 per day per competitor and riding spectator.

Non-Riding Spectators = \$10.00, Children below walking age are free

Everyone entering must sign release form. CTOR members do not pay land use fee.

People arriving before 7PM Friday will pay land use for Friday.

Camping per night = \$15.00 per night.

Event and Insurance fee per day:

Strider - Rookie = Free

Novice – Master = \$35.00

Dependent children = \$25.00

Non-comp riders = \$25.00

Camping:

- We have some available campsites with full hook ups, please contact Ben for availability info and **reservation at (512)743-6565** or ben@dalglish.net
- Only one camper per hookup.
- The Bathroom and Hot Shower are available for everyone to use. Shower has no door, bring swimsuit and a towel.
- Dump site available for campers not hooked up.

Rules (Please see <http://www.ridector.com/> for a complete set of rules and other C.T.O.R information)

- Riders must wear their helmets any time they are on their motorcycle.
- There is a 5 mph speed limit in the pit/camping area.
- Riders must stay on marked trail.
- No riding on dirt mounds or grass areas by camp unless marked as the loop. Grass is Cow and Lama food and is highly valued.
- No Side x Sides or sport ATVs allowed.
- Children must be supervised at all times.

Tips

- On Saturday loop, we will transport fuel jugs to the back gate to minimize riders need to return back to pit between loops. Please drop your fuel jug at sign up 15 minutes before your event start.
- A flushable commode and shower are provided at camp.
- Bring a towel. The shower is great for cooling off after a ride.
- Salado has great shopping, food, and several hotels. It can be busy on the weekends, so book your hotel early.
